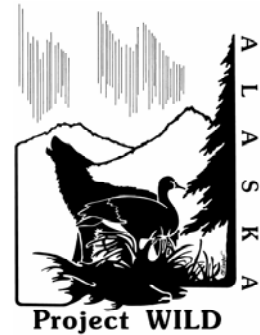




## Project Learning Tree & Project WILD
